

**Alexandru Nazare** is the Minister of Finance of Romania, a position he has held since June 2025. Prior to this, he served as a member of the Board of the National Bank of Romania from October 2024 to June 2025. He was also a Senator in the Romanian Parliament from December 2020 to June 2025 and previously served as Minister of Finance from December 2020 to July 2021. In 2020, he acted as Special Representative on Cybersecurity for the EU Cyber Centre. Nazare's parliamentary experience includes serving as a Member of Parliament from 2012 to 2016.

His earlier government career includes key roles in the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure, where he served as Minister (Feb–May 2012) and Deputy Minister (Sep 2010–Feb 2012), as well as in the Ministry of Finance (Deputy Minister, Feb–Nov 2010) and the Ministry of European Affairs (Deputy Minister, Sep 2009–Feb 2010). He also held positions in the European Parliament as Member (2008–2009) and Adviser (2007–2008), and served as Adviser in the Ministry of European Integration from 2005 to 2007.
