Deputy Minister for Development of Communities and Territories, Ukraine

Born on March 19, 1977, in Mariupol, Donetsk region, he graduated in 1999 from the Kyiv National University of Trade and Economics with a degree in Management of Foreign Economic Activity. In 2001, he obtained a Master's degree in Public Administration from the National Academy of Public Administration under the President of Ukraine, followed by a second Master's degree in 2017 from the Odessa National Maritime University in Organization of Transportation and Management in Transport, where he also qualified as a Researcher in the Field of Maritime Transport. Between 1996 and 2010, he held various managerial positions in both state institutions and commercial enterprises.

From 2010 to 2013, he served as Deputy Director of the State Enterprise "Maritime Security Agency," and from 2013 to 2025, he held several senior roles within the State Enterprise "Ukrainian Sea Ports Authority (USPA)," including Head of the Operational Response Center, Head of the Information Support Center, Head of the Service for Implementation and Compliance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code, Head and later Director of the Maritime Security Department, Deputy Chairman for International Affairs, and Acting Chairman. In recognition of his contributions, he was awarded the title of Honorary Worker of Maritime and River Transport. On January 24, 2025, he was appointed Deputy Minister for Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine by order of the Cabinet of Ministers.
