

Cristian BUȘOI

Born in 1978 in Drobeta-Turnu Severin, Romania, Cristian Bușoi holds a PhD in Public Health and Health Management. He graduated in Medicine from the “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Bucharest, studied Law at “Titu Maiorescu” University, and completed diplomatic studies at the Romanian Diplomatic Institute in Bucharest.

His political career began in 1996, when, as a young student, he joined the National Liberal Party. Eight years later, he became a Member of the Romanian Parliament, serving on the Committee for Health and Family. In 2013, he was appointed President of the National Health Insurance House.

His commitment in the Romanian Parliament earned him the trust of voters, who elected him to the European Parliament in 2007. He serves as a Member of the Committee on Environment, Public Health and Food Safety, the Delegation to the EU–Ukraine Parliamentary Association Committee, and the Euronest Parliamentary Assembly. He is also a substitute member of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection, the EU–Turkey Joint Parliamentary Committee, and the Delegation for relations with India.

He served as a Member of the European Parliament from 2007 to 2013 and has held this position again since 2014.
