

Vitaliy Kim is a Ukrainian politician and entrepreneur, currently serving as the Head of the Mykolaiv Regional State Administration.

He was born and raised in the city of Mykolaiv, where he attended Gymnasium No. 2 before continuing his studies at the Admiral Makarov National University of Shipbuilding, earning a degree in Business Economics.

He speaks fluent English and has knowledge of Korean and French.

He began his entrepreneurial career in 1998. He was an executive partner at the “Ushuaja” club and was involved in the construction sector. In 2003, he joined the company “Ukrpromresurs,” which specialized in audit and valuation services for the public sector.

Between 2005 and 2011, he held senior management positions in several Mykolaiv-based companies engaged in international investment activities.

In 2015–2016, he contributed to the organizational work of the Analytical Department within the Ministry of Agrarian Policy of Ukraine.

During the 2019 presidential and parliamentary elections, he worked in the Mykolaiv campaign headquarters of the “Servant of the People” party. In 2020, he led the party’s campaign during the local elections and ran for a seat in the Mykolaiv City Council.

On 25 November 2020, he was appointed Head of the Mykolaiv Regional State Administration.
